Project Description	<p>CareerSource Broward is providing employment to economically disadvantaged youth between the ages of 16-18 enrolled in Broward County Public Schools' Innovative Concepts (iCon) Program, subsidized summer employment opportunities for a maximum of 30-hours per week, for a period of up to 6 weeks.</p> <p>The program provides an opportunity for various employers to provide supervised, safe and meaningful summer employment opportunities to participating iCon students. The Career, Technical, Adult and Community Education Department will coordinate the summer program and provide assistance to employers that elect to participate in the program. CareerSource Broward will pay the wages for participants.</p>
Evaluation Plan	A training plan is developed for each student, in partnership with the employer, iCon teacher as the school, as well as the parent.
