RESOLUTION NO. 15-100

A RESOLUTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA CANVASSING THE RESULTS OF A BOND ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2014, IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, CONCERNING THE PROPOSED ISSUANCE BY THE DISTRICT OF NOT EXCEEDING \$800,000,000 AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF GENERAL OBLIGATION SCHOOL BONDS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. AUTHORITY FOR THIS RESOLUTION. This resolution is adopted pursuant to Section 1010.44, Florida Statutes, and other applicable provisions of law.

SECTION 2. **FINDINGS**. It is hereby ascertained, determined and declared that:

A. On November 4, 2014, a bond election was held within the area of the School District of Broward County, Florida (the "District"), pursuant to a resolution duly adopted by The School Board of Broward County, Florida (the "Board") on June 9, 2014, and notice of the same duly published prior thereto, as required by law, to submit to the qualified electors of the District the following question:

Funding Improvements to and Replacement of Public School Facilities Through Issuance of General Obligation Bonds

Shall the School District of Broward County fund improvements to and replacement of public school facilities throughout the District, including safety enhancements and instructional technology upgrades, by issuing general obligation bonds in a total principal amount not exceeding \$800,000,000, to be issued in multiple series, bearing interest at not exceeding maximum legal rates, maturing within thirty years, and secured by the full faith and credit and ad-valorem taxing power of the District?

B. Affidavits of publication of notice of the election in the *Sun Sentinel* are attached hereto as Exhibit A.

- C. As provided in the Certificate dated November 13, 2014, of the Broward County Canvassing Board, a copy of excerpted pages from which is attached hereto as Exhibit B, the total number of votes cast in the bond election was 441,852, of which 325,453 were in favor of the issuance of the proposed bonds and of which 116,399 were opposed thereto.
- D. It appears that the bond election has been duly and properly held in accordance with law and that the returns of the bond election have been delivered to the Board by the Broward County Canvassing Board for the purpose of canvassing the same and determining and certifying the results thereof.
- **SECTION 3. APPROVAL OF BONDS.** The proposed issuance of general obligation school bonds, heretofore described, was approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting in the bond election.
- **SECTION 4. DECLARATION OF RESULT**. This resolution shall constitute a declaration of result of the bond election and shall be recorded in the minutes of the Board as soon as possible. The Superintendent is hereby directed to provide a copy of this resolution to the Secretary of State Division of Elections.
- **SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

NO. 2 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT ARTICLE X, SECTION 29 USE OF MARIJUANA FOR CERTAIN MEDICAL CONDITIONS

Allows the medical use of marijuana for individuals with debilitating diseases as determined by a licensed Florida physician. Allows caregivers to assist patients' medical use of marijuana. The Department of Health shall register and regulate centers that produce and distribute marijuana for medical purposes and shall issue identification cards to patients and caregivers. Applies only to Florida law. Does not authorize violations of federal law or any non-medical use, possession or production of marijuana.

NO. 3 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT ARTICLE V, SECTIONS 10, 11 PROSPECTIVE APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN JUDICIAL VACANCIES

Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution requiring the Governor to prospectively fill vacancies in a judicial office to which election for retention applies resulting from the justice's or judge's reaching the mandatory retirement age or failure to qualify for a retention election; and allowing prospective appointments if a justice or judge is not retained at an election. Currently, the Governor may not fill an expected vacancy until the current justice's or judge's term expires.
