POSTING OF RFP RECOMMENDATION/TABULATION: RFP Recommendations and Tabulations will be posted in the Procurement & Warehousing Services and www.Demandstar.com on March 9, 2015, and will remain posted for 72 hours. Any person who is adversely affected by the decision or intended decision shall file a notice of protest, in writing, within 72 hours after the posting of the notice of decision or intended decision. The formal written protest shall be filed within ten (10) days after the date the notice of protest is filed. Failure to file a notice of protest or failure to file a formal written protest shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under this chapter. Section 120.57(3)(b), Florida Statutes, states that "The formal written protest shall state with particularity the facts and law upon which the protest is based." Saturdays, Sundays, state holidays and days during which the school district administration is closed shall be excluded in the computation of the 72-hour time period provided. Filings shall be at the office of the Director of Procurement & Warehousing Services, 7720 West Oakland Park Boulevard, Suite 323, Sunrise, Florida 33351. Any person who files an action protesting an intended decision shall post with the School Board, at the time of filing the formal written protest, a bond, payable to The School Board of Broward County, Florida, (SBBC), in an amount equal to one percent (1%) of the estimated value of the contract. Failure to post the bond required by SBBC Policy 3320, Part VIII, Purchasing Policies, Section N, within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of the right to protest.

(*) The Cone of Silence, as stated in the RFP, is in effect until this RFP is approved by SBBC. The School Board meeting date stated above is a tentative date. Confirm with the Purchasing Agent of record for the actual date the Cone of Silence has concluded.


RECOMMENDATION/TABULATION

The School Board of Broward County, Florida (SBBC) intends to take the following actions with regard to RFP 15-085C – Program Management Office Services:

(1) Reject all proposals submitted for RFP 15-085C – Program Management Office Services. SBBC intends to release new RFPs on or about March 25, 2015 for the Owner's Representatives and Cost Control Services based upon a business decision to revise the management approach of the SMART Capital Bond Projects. The revised RFPs will separately procure (a) owner's representatives services for design and construction and (b) cost and program control services.

(2) Reject all proposals submitted for RFP 15-085C – Program Management Office Services. All proposals are rejected as the terms and conditions of the RFP do not provide for award to any proposer other than the one selected by the evaluation committee and the proposal of that selected proposer has subsequently become non-responsive and ineligible for award.


(3) Reject the proposal submitted by Jacobs Engineering Group Inc. as non-responsive and ineligible for award pursuant to the terms and conditions of RFP 15-085C – Program Management Office Services, Rule 11 of School Board Policy 1100B, and Rule II-GG of School Board Policy 3320 as that proposer violated the Cone of Silence prior to the award of a contract under the RFP by The School Board.

The project management and program control services that will be solicited under the revised management approach will perform a vital role in the implementation of improvements to district school facilities to address indoor air quality and operational life safety systems, as identified by The School Board of Broward County, Florida in conjunction with the 2014 public bond referendum which was overwhelmingly approved by Broward County voters. These improvements include critically needed HVAC and roof replacement projects at over 200 of 238 schools and replacements and upgrades to fire alarm and sprinkler systems at more than half of the schools in the district. If necessary, the school district intends to invoke its authority under Section 120.57(3)(c), Florida Statutes, to proceed without delay in releasing these new RFPs.
