## Continuation of Summary Explanation and Background

On November 5, 2013, The School Board of Broward County, Florida, approved a charter application to open a new charter school for the start of the 2014-2015 academic year. At the June 24, 2014, Regular School Board Meeting, item L-10 The National Ben Gamla Charter School Foundation, Inc., was approved to defer the opening of the school until the 2015-2016 academic year. Ben Gamla Preparatory Charter High School will serve students in grades 9-12 and will open in August 2015.

Pursuant to Section 1002.33, Florida Statutes, the terms and conditions for the operation of a charter school shall be set forth by the charter school and The School Board of Broward County, Florida, in a written contractual agreement. This agreement shall constitute a school's charter.

In accordance with Florida Statutes, The School Board of Broward County, Florida, shall monitor and review the charter's revenues, expenditures, and progress toward the goals established in the charter. This is for an opening of a new charter school.

The Charter School will be located at 2650 Hollywood Boulevard, Hollywood, Florida 33020, which is in District 1.

The governing board members of The National Ben Gamla Charter School Foundation, reside in Broward County, Florida and Baltimore, Maryland.
