Pursuant to the Agreement, there is no cost to The School Board of Broward County, Florida. Coconut Creek High will be provided at no cost to the school two nights of lodging in Atlanta, Georgia for the football game (August 29, 2015). DeKalb County School District will pay for Coconut Creek High's hotel lodging costs and coach bus transportation. In addition, DeKalb County School District will provide Coconut Creek High athletes and coaches with two meals per day and a post-game snack. It is anticipated that the football game with a DeKalb County public high school will increase national and regional attention for the Broward County Public School system. The game is under consideration to be aired on national television by ESPN-U. The School Board of Broward County, Florida has approved similar agreements for out-of-state football games with Miramar, Cypress Bay and Cooper City High Schools.
