After a detailed investigation of the records, it was discovered that the Consultant of Record executed the relevant OEF 110b and OEF 209 Forms, in May of 2010. The Building Official did not sign the said documents, since there was a failed Fire Alarm Inspection ticket associated with this project. Resolution to the failed ticket required coordination with the SBBC Physical Plant Operations, which was finally resolved on February 11, 2015.

Action Plan:

The Office of Facilities & Construction is continuing to aggressively close out all outstanding projects. In addition, the Project Acceptance Form has not been included, due to the age of the project and the administration familiar with the project are no longer at the facility.
