1 (Title)	Revised the title of the policy	Provided a broad title and specified targeted audience in the definitions
1 (Title Overview)	Deleted previous title language; removed language that limited parking to seniors and students with a hardship	Align the overview with recommended title change and intent of the revised policy language
1 (Definitions)	Added definitions for key terms in the recommended revisions (motor vehicles, fee, permit/decal, and school campuses)	Provide clarity and consistency in the policy language
1 (Rules)	Moved definition of motor vehicles to the Definitions Section Moved hardship criteria to Rule 3	Language alignment Language realignment
1 (Rules #1)	Added statement regarding student risk	Further explain the driver's responsibility for his/her vehicle on campus
1 (Rules #2)	Added language to give priority for parking to seniors	Consistent with original intent of the policy
1 (Rules #3)	Revised language for hardship criteria	Provide schools with the direction for considering hardship requests for student parking
1 (Rules #4)	Added the word "decal"	Consistency of policy language
1 (Rules #4a)	Revised language to include the school's responsibility for establishing site-based processes and procedures for student parking	Gives each school the flexibility to set processes and procedures for issuing student parking permits/decals and revoking student driving privileges
2 (Rules #4b)	Deleted the word "operator's" and added Florida Class E (non-learner) or higher	Current classification of Florida driver's license
2 (Rules #4c)	Deleted financial responsibility language and added motor vehicle insurance language	Requires all student vehicles to have the state minimum requirements for motor

		vehicle insurance
2 (Rules #4d)	Added vehicle registration language Deleted state motor vehicle inspection law language	Requires all student vehicles to have current vehicle registration Vehicle inspections are no longer conducted in the state
2 (Rules #4e)	Added language for charging fees for student parking Deleted student citizenship language	Establishes a maximum amount for student parking fees for the school year The intent of this language is included in Rule #2a
2 (Rules #5)	Added reasonable search language Deleted reference to “one in one out”	Align language with Policy 5.8 (Code of Student Conduct) Methods for assigning permits/decals will be established by each school
2 (Rules #6)	Added language for communication of policy revision	Establish written expectation for schools to utilize all methods available to communicate policy revisions to students, parents and school employees on an annual basis
2 (Rules #7)	Added language to address non-school board owned property that is leased for student parking	Ensure that this policy applies to all property that is designated for student parking
2 General	Deleted language from the policy	All recommended revisions comply with state statute and the spirit of the intent for student parking privileges Communication of policy language has been included in Rule #4/
