- 4. The Fees for the Professional Development Services are due and payable no later than 30 days after receipt of invoice. Invoices will be sent at the end of each quarter for any and all professional development services delivered during the previous quarter.
- The date, time and place of the professional development services shall be mutually agreed to by the parties provided all professional development trainings shall be completed by no later than September 1 of each Term Period.
- Customer acknowledges that the rights granted by Discovery under this Agreement are at all times during the Term subject to and contingent upon a valid and current Customer License
- Any content provided by Discovery during the Professional Development, in any format ("the Content"), is the property of Discovery. Customer acknowledges that it does not gain any ownership interest in the Content by using the Content.
- 8. Customer is commissioning an evaluation report from a third party assessing the impact of, among other things, Discovery's services on learning goals within Park Ridge Elementary School (the "Evaluation Report"). The parties acknowledge that Discovery has discounted the Fees for the Professional Development Services provided through the Term as set forth above by \$8,000.00 and such discount is in full consideration for, and Customer hereby grants to Discovery, a license to access, publish, copy and otherwise use the Evaluation Report commissioned by Customer and any results included within the Evaluation Report in any format, for any reasonable business purposes including, without limitation, in Discovery's marketing and promotional materials.
- 9. <u>Background Checks</u>. Discovery represents and warrants the following regarding security clearances of those employees and independent contractors who deliver professional development services. Discovery conducts the following checks on any employees or contractors it sends onto school campuses to perform professional development and related services where students may be present ("PD Specialists") at the time of hire and refreshes such checks on an annual basis:
 - Criminal Records Check
 - FBI Fingerprint Clearance
 - Check of all state, local and tribal sex offender (and related) registries that are linked to the national search maintained by the United States Department of Justice Sex Offender Public Website located at http://www.nsopw.gov/



For the sake of clarity, the nature of the services offered by Discovery are such that Discovery's PD Specialists are always in the presence of and under the supervision of school district personnel. Further, Discovery agrees to provide, upon request, copies of records documenting the above-referenced background checks for such PD Specialists that shall be performing services on school grounds.

Discovery agrees to comply with Sections 1012.32 and 1012.465 of the Florida Statutes, as applicable. The parties agree that the failure of Discovery to comply with the requirements of Sections 1012.32 and 1012.465 of the Florida Statutes shall constitute a material breach of this Agreement entitling Customer to terminate immediately with no further responsibilities or duties to perform under this Agreement. Discovery agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Customer, its officers and employees from any third-party liability in the form of physical or mental injury, death or property damage resulting from Discovery's failure to comply with the requirements herein.

- 10. Discovery understands that government entities, such as Customer, may be required to disclose information pursuant to applicable open records acts. Prior to any such disclosure, Customer shall make any claim of privilege that may be applicable to prevent such disclosure and will make reasonable efforts to give Discovery reasonable prior notice and a reasonable opportunity to resist such disclosure. In all other respects, all provisions of this Agreement ("Confidential Information") shall be kept strictly confidential by Customer and may not be disclosed without prior written consent, except for any disclosure required by any order of a court or governmental authority with jurisdiction over Customer.
- 11. Customer certifies that Customer is exempt from all federal, state, and local taxes and will furnish Discovery with copies of all relevant certificates demonstrating such tax-exempt status upon request. In the event Customer is not exempt from certain of such taxes, Customer agrees to remit payment for such taxes to Discovery.
- 12. Customer may terminate this Agreement for convenience and without cause upon thirty days written notice to Discovery. In the event of such termination, Customer shall pay Discovery for all services rendered through the effective date of the termination.
- 13. This Agreement contains the entire understanding and supersedes all prior understandings between the parties relating to the subject matter herein. The terms and conditions set forth herein shall not be binding on Discovery, or any of its affiliates, until fully executed by an authorized signatory for both Customer and Discovery (or its applicable affiliate). Signatures may be exchanged in counterparts. Signatures transmitted electronically by fax or PDF shall be binding and effective as original ink signatures.
