Project Description	Certiport provides students with access and practice in order to develop and attain the required skills for industry certifications in career and technical programs that exist in our middle, high, and technical magnet schools. Certiport is a sole source provider of the products that facilitates teacher training, student practice of industry certification exams, and student industry certification attainment in the following: Microsoft Office Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Access, and Outlook, Adobe Dreamweaver, Photoshop (Creative Cloud), Flash, Premier-Pro. Intuit QuickBooks, AutoCAD User, AutoCAD Professional, AutoCAD User Revit, AutoCAD Professional Revit, AutoCAD User Inventor, AutoCAD Professional Inventor, AutoCAD Professional Civil, IC3, Spark. As a point of reference, if all exams reported to the FLDOE through the Certiport delivery system last year, were purchased individually, the approximate cost would have been in excess of \$900,000. Additionally, this year select elementary schools will be included in a pilot program for Digital Tools Certifications, which aligns with the mandate set forth by SB 850.
