Project Description	The School Board of Broward County, Florida has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$493,565 for the Out of School Youth Program funded by CareerSource Broward from Federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) funds. The program will serve two hundred (200) youth who are between the ages of 16-24, and meet WIOA eligibility requirements for out-of-school youth who have not completed high school or obtained a GED. These funds will provide additional assistance to obtain the high school credential. The program design includes individual career pathway plans, employability skills development, financial literacy skills, and on the job training delivered by three state-certified teachers and two job coaches.
Evaluation Plan	Grant deliverables are reviewed by CareerSource Broward through monthly meetings with CTACE for quality control and grant compliance.
Research Methodology	Evaluation plan is aligned with Federal Regulations (WIOA), as the Federal Government is the source of funds received by CareerSource Broward.
