REQUESTED ACTION:

Approve award of Design/Build Agreement between The School Board of Broward County, Florida and JWR Construction, Inc., for the City of Parkland Classroom Additions project pursuant to RFP 15-081C, and approve amendment to the District Educational Facilities Plan (DEFP), Fiscal Years 2015-16, to include three (3) classroom additions each at Heron Heights ES and Park Trails ES.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Construction Bid Recommendation of \$50,000 or Greater – RFP 15-081C (2nd Re-bid)

City of Parkland Classroom Additions

The School Board of Broward County, Florida received five (5) proposals in response to RFP 15-081C (2nd Re-bid) City of Parkland Classroom Additions. The Qualification Selection Evaluation Committee (QSEC) reviewed and evaluated this Request for Proposals (RFP) on August 19, 2015, and is recommending JWR Construction Services, Inc., for award in the amount of \$1,871,561. The Design/Build services will provide for three (3) classrooms at Heron Heights Elementary and three (3) classrooms at Park Trails Elementary to be substantially complete by May 23, 2016 and achieve Final Completion by July 20, 2016.

BACKGROUND

On March 17, 2014, The School Board of Broward County, Florida, approved the Modular Classroom Agreement with the City of Parkland for the District to construct, maintain, and operate seven (7) permanent modular classrooms in the corporate limits of the City. Funding for the classrooms, in accordance with the Agreement, was to be derived from funds received by the City from several developers. The original Agreement anticipated receipt of \$1,771,000 to be made in installments for the construction of seven (7) modular classrooms. Furthermore, the Agreement identified the potential for an additional payment of \$254,000, on or before February 15, 2015, for the construction of one (1) additional modular classroom.

On October 21, 2014, the Board approved the Authorization to Advertise for Design/Build Services. Although the last payment had not yet been received, the Authorization to Advertise identified eight (8) modular classrooms to be built at Park Trails ES, in anticipation that the full \$2,025,000 would be available to construct all eight (8) classrooms. The Board item was amended that day to reflect consideration of four (4) units at Park Trails ES and four (4) units at Heron Heights ES, as an alternate to be considered, if the cost came in within the \$2,025,000 budget.

Subsequent to Board approval of the Authorization to Advertise, Procurement & Warehousing Services released Request for Proposals 15-081C (RFP) for Design/Build Services for four (4) modular classrooms at Park Trails ES and four (4) modular classrooms at Heron Heights ES. The RFP was advertised on October 27, 2014, with a bid opening date of November 17, 2014. Although the bidding community expressed interest in the project, there were no responses to the RFP, necessitating reissuance of the RFP for Design/Build Services for the design and construction of a four (4) classroom addition at Park Trails ES and a four (4) classroom addition at Heron Heights ES. The RFP was re-advertised on February 11, 2015, with a bid opening date of March 4, 2015. Response to this bid included two non-responsive bids and one responsive bid. Prior to award, a cone of silence violation occurred by the selected Design/Build firm, forcing rejection of all bids that was approved by the Board on June 23, 2015.

On May 1, 2015, a 2nd rebid of the RFP occurred. The RFP was advertised on May 1, 2015 with a bid opening date of June 24, 2015. Five (5) proposals were received in response to this RFP. On July 8, 2015, QSEC convened and selected a Design/Builder. Negotiations with the selected firm were conducted on July 15, 2015, however, these were unsuccessful and ended in an impasse. On that same day the First Amendment of the Agreement between The School Board of Broward County, Florida and the City of Parkland occurred, due to increased construction costs and a loss of originally anticipated contribution payments to the City and subsequently to the School District, reducing the budget from \$2,025,000 to

\$1,905,000 and reducing the number of units from eight (8) to seven (7). The First Amendment to the Agreement also specifically contemplated the possibility of further reduction of classroom units and an extension of time to reach Final Completion. The new budget of \$1,905,000, less monies expended for the removal of portables at Riverglades ES resulted in a net of \$1,871,561 for construction of the classrooms.

Following the impasse, a new Design/Build firm had to be selected. Due to lack of a provision in the RFP to address moving to the second ranked firm, QSEC had to be reconvened on August 19, 2015. Additionally, some corrections had to be made regarding the composition of QSEC, and rescoring of the five (5) proposers was carried out. This resulted in a different Design/Build firm being selected, namely JWR Construction Services, Inc. Negotiations were conducted with JWR on the same day as they were selected. The negotiations specifically discussed the following:

Reduction of JWR's proposal to meet the approved budget of \$1,871,561. Items agreed to as part of this discussion included reduction of cost for Divisions 1 thru 17, Design Fee, Bonds and Insurance, and Owner's Contingency.

This resulted in a reduced cost, however, both parties were unable to reach consensus. Since the budget was fixed, with no option to increase, it was agreed that the only means by which to meet the budget would be to reduce scope by one (1) unit. It was agreed that the reduction by one (1) classroom would occur at Heron Heights ES. By doing so, JWR was able to establish a cost within the budget of \$1,871,561.

On August 25, 2015, a letter was issued by the Superintendent of Schools to the City of Parkland's City Manager explaining the outcome of the August 19, 2015 QSEC meeting and subsequent negotiations. The letter also requested acknowledgement and agreement in writing to the reduction of classroom units to six (6) and an extension of the Final Completion date to July 20, 2016. On August 28, 2015, the City of Parkland called a Special Commission Meeting to address the classrooms at the two schools, specifically the reduction from seven (7) units to six (6), and the extension of the schedule for a later opening date than had previously contemplated. After discussion, the City of Parkland's commission voted unanimously in favor of the requested changes.

This item requests approval of the award to JWR Construction Services, Inc. for the design and construction of a three (3) classroom addition at Heron Heights ES and a three (3) classroom addition at Park Trails ES for the sum of \$1,871,561. Additionally, the item requests an amendment of Addendum #2 of the DEFP 2015-16 to include a three (3) classroom addition at Heron Heights ES and a three (3) classroom addition at Park Trails ES. Addendum #2, approved during the First Public Hearing of the TDEFP on August 18, 2015, removed the eight (8) modular classroom addition at Riverglades ES, added a four (4) classroom modular addition at Heron Heights ES and added a two (2) to four (4) modular classroom addition at Park Trails ES.

^{*} While reviewing the documents, staff realized there was an error in the process regarding Policy 7003, Pre-Qualification of Contractors and Selection of Architects, Engineers, Design Builders, Construction Managers, and Total Program Managers; there were errors concerning the voting members on QSEC. In an abundance of caution, the committee conducted a special meeting to ensure compliance with Policy 7003. With the guidance of the Office of the General Counsel, a special evaluation meeting was held to ensure all policies were adhered to.

The special meeting involved staff restarting the entire evaluation process. The meeting was noticed and recorded as required by Sunshine Law, Section 1001.372, and Florida Statute 286.01. The outcome of the scores changed and JWR Construction Services, Inc. (JWR) was the successful respondent to the RFP.

Immediately following the evaluation of the proposal, District staff and QSEC conducted negotiations with JWR. The process was done in this manner because QSEC is required to make a motion to award a recommended vendor.

DOCUMENT 00500 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE OWNER AND THE DESIGN/BUILDER

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this <u>8th</u> day of <u>September, 2015</u>, by and between

JWR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES 1311 West Newport Center Drive, Suite C Deerfield Beach, Florida 33442

(Hereinafter referred to as the "Design/Builder" and

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA

(Hereinafter referred to as the "Owner" or "SBBC")

WHEREAS, the Design/Builder is desirous of performing the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents and all applicable laws, codes and ordinances.

NOW THEREFORE, in exchange for the mutual covenants and promises set forth herein and the sums of moneys agreed to be paid by the Owner to Design/Builder, the parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1. SCOPE OF THE WORK

1.1 The Design/Builder shall furnish all of the design services, construction, materials, labor, and other services as necessary to perform all of the work as described and delineated in the design criteria packages entitled:

Project Name: RFP 15-081C, City of Parkland Classroom Additions (2nd Rebid)

Project No.: **P.001629 – Heron Heights**

Project No.: P.001608 - Park Trails

and shall do everything required by this Agreement, the General Conditions of the Contract, the Design/Criteria Packages, Addenda thereto, and other proposals made by the Design/Builder as may have been accepted by the Owner during the selection of the Design/Builder in response to the Request for Proposals as part of the above named Design Criteria Packages. The said documents and Addenda thereto (if any) are by reference made a part and parcel of this agreement, the same as if they were written herein word for word.

ARTICLE 2. CONTRACT SUM

2.1 The Owner shall pay and the Design/Builder shall accept, as full and complete payment for the Design/Builder's timely performance of its obligations hereunder, a Final Guaranteed Maximum Price ("GMP") to be established at 60% completion of Design Documents, in an amount not to exceed:

One Million, Eight Hundred Seventy-One Thousand, Five Hundred Sixty-One Dollars (\$1,871,561.00)

ARTICLE 3. TIME FOR COMPLETION

- 3.1 Upon execution of the contract by both the Design/Builder and the Owner, submittal of the required performance and payment bonds, certificates of insurance, and receipt and approval of the required post-bid information, the Owner will issue **Document 00550**, **Notice to Proceed** which will stipulate the commencement date for the Work.
- 3.2 Liquidated Damages for Substantial Completion:
- 3.2.1 Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00) per day for each and every calendar day of unexcused delay in achieving Substantial Completion beyond the date set forth in Document 00550, Notice to Proceed, for Substantial Completion of each phase, if phased, or the project, if not phased.
- 3.2.2 Owner and Design/Builder acknowledge that any sums due and payable hereunder by the Design/Builder shall be payable, not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages representing a reasonable estimate of delay damages, inconvenience expenses, and additional overhead and costs, likely to be sustained by the Owner, estimated at the time of executing this Contract. If the Owner reasonably believes in its discretion that Substantial Completion will be delayed, the Owner shall be entitled, but not required, to withhold from any amounts otherwise due the Design/Builder an amount then believed by the Owner to be adequate to recover liquidated damages applicable to such delays. If and when in Owner's discretion the Design/Builder overcomes the delay in achieving Substantial Completion, or any part thereof, for which the Owner has withheld payment, the Owner shall release to the Design/Builder those funds withheld, but no longer applicable, as liquidated damages.
- 3.2.3. Partial use or occupancy of the Work shall not result in the Work being deemed substantially completed, and such partial use or occupancy shall not be evidence of Substantial Completion.

3.2.4. Substantial Completion, in the context of this Contract, does not refer to any prior dates wherein the Owner employs other contractors to work on the same site of the Project or Work.

ARTICLE 4. SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION AND FINAL PAYMENT

- 4.1 Substantial Completion: May 23, 2016
- 4.1.1 After passing all Final inspections required by the Building Department, when the Design/Builder believes that Substantial Completion has been achieved, the Design/Builder shall notify the Design Criteria Professional (DCP) in writing and shall provide to the DCP a list of those matters yet to be finished. Design/Builder shall also provide to DCP all fully executed documents required by the Chief Building Official (CBO) to consider the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy (form OEF 110B). Such fully executed documents shall include, but not be limited to Health Department approvals, NFPA 72 certificate for fire alarm, NFPA 13 for fire sprinklers, Civil Engineers site certification, etc. Once all documentation is received by the DCP, the DCP and Owner shall jointly determine whether the Work (or portion thereof) is appropriately ready for a Substantial Completion Inspection.
- 4.1.2 If the DCP and Owner determine that the Work is ready for a Substantial Completion Inspection, the DCP, Owner, and the CBO (or designee) shall conduct an inspection of the Work. If the DCP and CBO (or designee) determine the Work to be Substantially Complete, the DCP and CBO shall execute a Certificate of Occupancy (OEF 110B). The OEF 110B shall indicate the date of receipt (by the DCP) of the Design/Builder's written notice pursuant to article 4.1.1 as the "Intended Occupancy Date" on the face of the OEF 110B form. The executed OEF 110B together with an attached list of items remaining to be completed or corrected shall be provided to the DCP.
- 4.1.3. After execution of the OEF 110B by the CBO and the DCP, the "Intended Occupancy Date" shall be established as the date of Substantial Completion for the Work or specific portion thereof.
- 4.1.4 After Substantial Completion of the Work in its entirety, and upon Board approval, the Owner shall pay the Design/Builder an amount sufficient to increase total payments to the Design/Builder to the Contract Price (exclusive of retainage), less any amounts attributable to liquidated damages, together with 150 percent of the reasonable costs (as determined by the Owner at its sole discretion), for completing Work, correcting and bringing into conformance all defective and nonconforming Work and

- handling any outstanding or threatened claims or any other matters which could cause the Owner damage, cost, expense or delay.
- 4.2 Final Completion: July 20, 2016
- 4.2.1 After achieving Substantial Completion, and after completing or correcting all outstanding items previously identified, when the Design/Builder believes that Final Completion has been achieved, the Design/Builder shall notify the DCP in writing. The DCP and Owner shall thereafter jointly determine whether the Work is ready for a Final Completion Inspection.
- 4.2.2 As a condition precedent to achieving Final Completion, Design/Builder shall provide the Owner, in the form and manner required by Owner, if any, with a copy to the DCP, of the following:
- 4.2.2.1. An affidavit that all of the Design/Builder's obligations to subcontractors, laborers, equipment or suppliers, or other third parties in connection with the Project, have been paid or otherwise satisfied;
- 4.2.2.2. Such other documents as required by the Owner from each subcontractor, lower tier subcontractor, laborer, supplier or other person or entity who has or might have a claim against the Owner;
- 4.2.2.3. All warranties, guarantees, operating manuals, instruction manuals and other things or documents customarily required of the Design/Builder, or reasonably required by Owner, including but not limited to those required elsewhere in the Contract Documents, as part of its Project Closeout procedures.
- 4.2.3. If the Work is determined by the DCP and Owner to be ready for a Final Completion Inspection Inspection, the Design/Builder shall request a Final Completion Inspection from the Building Department. The CBO or Certified Inspector shall conduct an inspection of the Work. If the Work is determined by the DCP, Owner and the CBO or Certified Inspector to be Finally Complete, a Certificate of Final Inspection (OEF 209) shall be executed by the DCP, CBO or Certified Inspector, and after Board approval of Final Acceptance and release of retainage, execution by the Superintendent of Schools. If the Work in its entirety is determined to be Finally Complete, the date of receipt by the DCP of the Design/Builder's written notice pursuant to article 4.2.1 above shall be identified on page two of the OEF 209 as the "Completion Date." The Completion Date indicated on the OEF 209 shall be the date of Final Completion.
- 4.2.4 When the DCP, Owner and the CBO or Certified Inspector confirm that the Work is complete in full accordance with the Contract Documents and has passed all required inspections, including but not limited to those required

by the State Department of Education, and/or from any and all governmental bodies, boards, entitles, etc., and that the Design/Builder has performed all of its obligations to the Owner, and after execution of the OEF 209 by the DCP and CBO or Certified Inspector, the DCP will provide a final Approval for Payment to the Owner certifying to the Owner that the Project is complete and the Design/Builder is entitled to the remainder of the unpaid Contract Price, less any amount withheld pursuant to Contract Documents.

- 4.3 Liquidated Damages for Final Completion:
- 4.3.1 If the Design Builder fails to achieve Final Completion within 60 days of the date of Substantial Completion, the Design Builder shall pay the Owner the sum of:
- 4.3.2 **Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00)** per day for each and every calendar day of unexcused delay in achieving final completion beyond the date set forth for final completion of the Work.
- 4.3.3 Any sums due and payable hereunder by the Design/Builder shall be payable, not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages representing a reasonable estimate of delay damages, inconvenience expenses, and additional overhead and costs likely to be sustained by the Owner, estimated at or before the time of executing this Contract. When the Owner reasonably believes that final completion will be inexcusably delayed, the Owner shall be entitled, but not required, to withhold from any amounts otherwise due the Design/Builder an amount then believed by the Owner to be adequate to recover liquidated damages applicable to such delays.
- 4.4 Final Payment
- 4.4.1. Prior to being entitled to receive final payment and as a condition precedent thereto, the Design/Builder shall have achieved Final Completion as defined herein above, and the Board shall approve Final Acceptance and Release of Retainage.
- 4.4.2. The Owner shall, subject to its rights set forth in the Contract Documents, make final payment of all sums due the Design/Builder within thirty (30) days of Board approval of Final Acceptance and Release of Retainage.

ARTICLE 7. ACCEPTANCE AND PAYMENTS

- 7.1. Up to and including completion of 50 percent of total value of the Work, the Owner may make progress payments during the progress of the Work in amounts not to exceed 90 percent of the amount due as certified by the Design/Builder and approved by the Owner's designated representative. Thereafter, and until Final Completion, the Owner may make progress payments in amounts not to exceed 95 percent of the amount due as certified by the Design/Builder and approved by the Owner's designated representative.
- 7.2 If the Design/Builder has failed to complete the Work within 15 days of the date specified within the NTP, the Owner, at his option, may cancel the NTP and have the Work completed by another contractor, design/builder, his own forces, or the Design/Builder's surety.
- 7.2.1. Ten percent (10%) of the Contract Price shall be withheld whenever partial progress payments are payable until the Work is 50 percent complete. Thereafter, 5 percent (5%) shall be withheld until Board approval of Final Acceptance and Release of Retainage.

ARTICLE 8. CONTRACT TERMINATION

8.1. Refer to Section 00700-General Conditions, Articles 41 and 43

ARTICLE 9. PROTECTION OF OWNER'S PROPERTY

9.1. At all times during the performance of this contract, the Design/Builder shall protect the Owner's property from all damage whatsoever on account of the work being performed under this contract.

ARTICLE 10. INSURANCE REQUIRED

10.1 Refer to Article 44 of the General Conditions and Article 3.29.11.5 of the RFP.

ARTICLE 11. PERFORMANCE BOND AND PAYMENT BOND

11.1. The Contract shall become effective and in full force upon the execution of this agreement, concurrently with the delivery of performance bonds and payment bonds as set forth in Article 45 of the General Conditions of the Contract.

ARTICLE 12. DESIGN SERVICES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

12.1 The Design/Builder agrees to provide complete professional architectural and engineering services set forth in the Phases enumerated hereinafter and in compliance with the Florida Building Code and amendments thereto (the FBC), and the Florida Department of Education's State Requirements for Educational Facilities (SREF), in effect as of the date of this Agreement, including all civil, structural, mechanical, electrical engineering, interior design, landscape architectural design, and other related professional services normally required for a project of specific type as follows:

12.2. Construction Documents Phase:

- 12.2.1 From the Owner accepted Phase II proposal submittal, the Design/Builder shall prepare for approval by the Owner and State Department of Education, and in accordance with Owner's format, Final Construction Documents setting forth in detail the requirements for the construction of the Project in accordance with the Design Criteria Packages. the FBC and SREF. The Design/Builder is responsible for full compliance of the design and the Construction Documents with SREF and all applicable codes and jurisdictions referenced therein. The most stringent requirements of the applicable codes or referenced standards shall apply. Design/Builder, upon approval of the Owner, may submit separate documents for site development (including demolition, abatement of hazardous materials, earthwork, etc.) as needed to allow for project scheduling considerations. Work defined in said phased document submittals may begin upon receipt of approval of those phased documents by the Department of Education as further discussed below.
- 12.2.2 The Final Construction Documents shall be developed in accordance with SREF Article 4.4(8) and shall include the following elements of a Design Development (Phase II) submittal packages (defined in SREF Article 4.4(7)) as required by Article 4.4(8) where Phase I and II documents have not been submitted for the Department of Education's review. At the Owner's option, and with the approval of the Department of Education, the Department of Education's review may be undertaken by members of the Owner's staff or other agency assigned to complete the review.

- 12.2.3 The Design/Builder shall coordinate and cooperate with the Owner concerning submittal procedures and protocol for delivering construction documents and any approvals required by The School Board of Broward, County prior to submittal of construction documents to the Department of Education.
- 12.2.4 The Design/Builder shall cooperate fully to ensure timely review of the Construction Documents by the reviewing agency. The Design/Builder shall make all required changes or additions and resolve all questions on the documents resulting from the Department of Education Review, including resubmittals and review by the Department of Education if said resubmittal is required as a result of the initial review.
- 12.2.5 In addition to the number and types of document sets required by the Department of Education, the Design/Builder shall submit 2 complete sets of all documents to the Owner and shall include an updated copy of the Project Development Schedule.
- 12.2.6 The Design/Builder shall be responsible for filing the required documents for approval by all governmental authorities or agencies having jurisdiction over the Project and for obtaining certifications of "permit approval" by reviewing authorities prior to construction or as required during the appropriate sequence of construction.
- 12.2.7 The Design/Builder shall make original documents or reproducible copies thereof available to the Owner for reproduction of additional copies as may be required for informational and BCI inspection purposes.

The purpose of this correspondence is to provide you with the status regarding the design and construction of the modular classrooms called for in the Modular Classroom Agreement between The School Board of Broward County, Florida (SBBC) and the City of Parkland. As you know, this project has experienced unanticipated challenges and delays; however, District staff in collaboration with the City has consistently worked to meet these challenges to ensure that the intent of this important project timeline is met. To this point, the District's QSEC met on August 19, 2015 to select a vendor to construct the classrooms. In the interest of providing as much information as possible throughout this process, the District greatly appreciated the City of Parkland allowing Carol Morris to participate in this QSEC process.

At the conclusion of QSEC, JWR Construction Services was selected to construct the modular classrooms. JWR was the highest ranked proposer of the companies that responded to the RFP. As the highest ranked proposer, pursuant to the RFP, JWR and the District made best efforts to negotiate the entire project scope into an agreement, but we were unable accommodate the provision of all classrooms for the total amount of funds available. However, through negotiations, we reached an agreement for JWR to design and construct six (6) modular classrooms consistent with 2(g) of the First Amendment to the Modular Classroom Addition, as opposed to the seven (7) modular classrooms that reduced the overall cost to be in alignment with the available funds. Also, aligned with Section 2(f) of the same agreement, the negotiations included an extension of the Final Completion date from March 21, 2016 to July 20, 2016.

The Procurement & Warehousing Department has advised that the selection of JWR Construction Services, contingent on confirmation from the City of Parkland of alignment with Section 2(f) and 2 (g) of the agreement, will be scheduled for SBBC consideration/approval at a special School Board meeting that is slated for September 8, 2015. It is intended that the contract between the SBBC and JWR Construction Services to construct the six (6) modular classrooms will be scheduled for the same Board meeting.

The District is interested in proceeding towards the design and construction of the modular classrooms. So that we may do so, and consistent with Sections 2(f) and 2(g) of the First Amendment to the Modular Classroom Addition, it is kindly requested that you acknowledge and agree in writing to the reduction of classroom units to six (6) and an extension of the Final Completion date to July 20, 2016.

If the City objects in moving forward, please contact me immediately at (754) 321-2600, or contact Leslie Brown, Chief Portfolio Services Officer at (754) 321-2100 or via email at leslie.brown@browardschools.com. I understand that selected District staff are slated to meet with you and your staff on August 27, 2015. During that meeting, staff would elaborate further on this matter and respond to any additional questions not covered by this letter.
