Continuation of the School Health Services Plan 2014-2016 Amendment with The School Board of Broward County, Florida.

Continuation of Summary Explanation and Background

This bill requires public schools to provide immediate notification to a student's parent, guardian or caregiver if a student is removed from school, school transportation or a school-sponsored activity and taken to a facility for an involuntary examination under Section 394.451, (4) (a) (19), Florida Statute-The Baker Act. The State has added Senate Bill 954 requirement to the School Health Services Plan 2014-2016 for county school health programs to formalize local steps to be taken. The addition to the School Health Services Plan 2014-2016 is noted on Page 26, Part IV.2.

The Florida Department of Health-Broward has requested the approval of the Board for the amendment to the School Health Services Plan 2014-2016.
