

REQUESTED ACTION:

Approve the Reciprocal Use Agreement between The School Board of Broward County, Florida and the City of Lauderhill.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:

The current Reciprocal Use Agreement (RUA) between The School Board of Broward County, Florida (SBBC) and the City of Lauderhill was entered into on June 13, 2011. The Agreement is scheduled to expire on June 12, 2016. This RUA contains prior School Board approved solutions to issues (such as the District's implementation of its Four-Day Summer Work Week and the potential resultant increase in facility costs and energy cost) certain municipalities raised a few years ago regarding their utilization of the District's school facilities. The City has indicated its desire to renew the RUA with SBBC. ~~This agreement will be executed by the City of Lauderhill after School Board approval.~~ This Agreement has been reviewed and approved as to form and legal content by the Office of the General Counsel.
