Continuation Agreement with Nova Southeastern University, Inc.

Renewal of Contract between the School Board of Broward County, Florida, and Nova Southeastern University, Inc.

Additional Background Information:

Nova Southeastern University, Inc. (NSU) has been partnering with Broward County Schools, Florida to provide three magnet high school summer enrichment programs for students. The three programs are the Aviation Program at Miramar High School, the Marine Science Program at South Broward High School, and the Emerging Computer Technology and Digital Entrepreneurship Program at Dillard High School. NSU will host the annual summer programs for up to thirty (30) students in each program beginning June 20, 2016 and concluding on June 24, 2016 for Miramar's Aviation and Dillard's Computer camp; and for South Broward's Marine Science camp beginning June 27, 2016 and concluding July 1, 2016.

The teachers (up to three for each program) will be paid a stipend of \$600 per teacher. Teachers will be participating and learning the content along with the students in the sessions that will be delivered by NSU and a community organization with the content knowledge and expertise aligned to each program accordingly. The total stipend for all nine teachers will be \$5,400 and funded by Title II, Part A.
