- Public online access to student editions of the District recommended instructional materials
- An open and noticed school board hearing during which the public may comment on the recommended instructional materials
- An open and noticed public meeting to approve an annual instructional
 materials plan to identify any instructional materials that will be purchased
 through the district school board instructional materials review process

Communication Plan:

Pre-Adoption:

- Notice in newspaper and on homepage of BEEP notifying teachers and parents of recommended instructional materials
