Status of Work:

The Contractor completed the scope of work per the Completion Agreement and Final Inspection passed on January 15, 2013. The Certificate of Occupancy (OEF 110B) was executed on October 21, 2014, and the Certificate of Final Inspection (OEF 209) will be executed upon Board approval of this change order. There are no additional change orders after this current request is approved.

Key Issues:

This item is comprised of two (2) change order items, one of which is an <u>unforeseen condition</u> and the other being an <u>Owner's</u> request.

- The <u>unforeseen condition</u> to add 41 non-compensable days is due to inclement weather that was above the normal average rainfall as verified by readings from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA).
- The <u>Owner's request</u> credit for material and labor is due to the deletion of roof coping caps that was removed from the Contractor's scope of work, as it was inclusive in the Roof Replacement project (3461-24-05).
