Registration ...

Automatic for students currently going to either school

Incoming Kindergarten - Tuesday May 10 at Hallandale Elementary

K-5 will register in Hallandale Elementary

5th graders will do the registration packet MINUS proof of address

Middle school will continue at Gulfstream

Students currently on re-assignment will remain on reassignment –

- New reassignments are not being accepted at this time – We can revisit this topic at a later time

Aug 1st, 2016 – Aug 12th, 2016

Invitations for upcoming events will start going out to the community and parents

Current Elementary ...

SOUTH Campus – Grades K – 3

Current Adult Center ...

NORTH campus – Grades 4-8

Logistics ...

We will have 2 parent pick-up and drop-off loops

Athletics ...

Soccer, Basketball, Football, Volleyball, Cheerleading & Track and Field

STEM ...

Both schools already offer the STEM programs ... Mr. Pappas has requested the programs be increased & expanded

Dual Language, Band and Chess Club will be staying.

Uniforms ...

Both schools will remain uniform schools.

How will the students be mixed?

Students will be assigned their own areas according to grade level ...

- Example ... 4th and 8th graders will not be placed together

Paraprofessionals?**Bus Area ...**

Something that is being contemplated is the logistics of the bus loop.

- It will be supervised

A parent thanked Mr. Pappas for all his hard work regarding this transition.

She wants to make sure the class sizes stay small.

She had several questions regarding her child's education and the effect this move might have on her child.

Parent Questions and Responses have been listed below ...

- Will it affect my child's music and cultural classes?
- How will this better my child's education?

Mr. Pappas advised the parents that the move will not cause a negative impact.

Some key points he addressed included:

- No additional students will be added to any of the grade levels.
- District class size laws will be followed.
- All the same students will be attending.
- Collaboration will add to student education.
- Teachers and principal will grow and become more educated with this collaboration.

Police Officers ...

Parents requested that a School Resource Officer be placed at the new campuses.

Mr Pappas advised that Mayor Cooper is cooperating and we will have at least one assigned.

School Colors ...

School colors will be the same as the buildings.

- Updates will be made over time
- Blue was the community suggestion based on the commonality between the two schools.

School Sign ...

The school sign will be more visible to parents and visitors.

A school marquee will also be placed in front of the North Campus

Naming of the School ...

Mr. Pappas reviewed policy 1401 with all the stakeholders present regarding the process of naming the school.

Mr. Pappas asked that all suggestions be emailed to him by Monday May 9th, 2016.

- Committee was formed to narrow down the name of the schools based on feedback provided via email.
- Committee will complete this task on Monday May 9th, 2016.
- Suggestions for the school mascot were asked to be emailed
- Voting on the school name will take place on Tuesday May 10th at Gulfstream Middle School and Hallandale Elementary
- School name that receives the most votes will be submitted to the principal.

Mr. Pappas will forward the result to the Superintendent's office.

Upon receipt, the school name will be forwarded to the board for final approval.
