SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND Continued

Pursuant to Paragraph 15 of the Agreement, neither party of the Agreement would make renovations or alter the premises, or any part thereof, in any manner whatsoever without first obtaining the written approval from the other party. On December 23, 2015, the School District received correspondence from the City informing the District of the City intent to perform renovations and improvements to the Facility, which renovations and improvements would involve a temporary closure of the Facility. The intended renovations and improvements would include repairs to the 50 meter olympic pool, of which, District schools use for swimming related programs. The City has stated that the repairs are necessary to comply with the new olympic and collegiate standards and anticipate renovations and improvements to begin on or after August 8, 2016 and completed by February 24, 2017.

Currently, four (4) District schools, Coral Glades High School, Coral Springs High School, Douglas High School and Taravella High School use the Facility to host Boys and Girls Swimming and Water Polo Programs. The Programs are said to follow the Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA) calendar which begins the first week in August and goes through the first week in November for swimming and diving classes, and mid-January and go through mid-April for water polo classes.

The City is requesting the SBBC written approval to perform the needed renovations and improvements to the Facility, as required in Paragraph 15, of the existing Agreement.
