

RESOLUTION NO. 88-217

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL SPRINGS AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A FORTY YEAR LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BROWARD COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD AND THE CITY FOR USE OF THE AQUATIC COMPLEX BY BOTH PARTIES

WHEREAS, the SCHOOL BOARD has applied for and received a grant to fund and construct a community educational facility; and

WHEREAS, the SCHOOL BOARD and the CITY actively support and endorse the concept of providing an Aquatics Complex; and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 1987, the SCHOOL BOARD and the CITY entered into an Interlocal Agreement for purposes of delineating the construction, funding, and operational procedures for the Coral Springs Aquatic Complex; and

WHEREAS, one of the provisions of the Interlocal Agreement was that the School Board and City would enter into a forty-year lease agreement for use of the Aquatic Complex by both parties, said Lease Agreement attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A;" and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Coral Springs deems it to be in the best interests of the citizens of the City to authorize the execution of the Lease Agreement between the SCHOOL BOARD and the CITY; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL SPRINGS, FLORIDA:

That the appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to execute the Lease Agreement between the SCHOOL BOARD and the CITY OF CORAL SPRINGS, attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A," providing for use of the Aquatic Complex by both parties for a period of forty years.
