

## **A+ Grades**

- Districts may award plus (+) grades
- BCPS currently awards B+, C+, and D+ grades in the weighted GPA (class rank)
- Plus grades are not recognized by
  - Florida's colleges and universities
  - Bright Futures Scholarships, or
  - NCAA
- Committee consensus is to not award A+ grades

  - Demonstrate skills and competency in locating information
  - Applying technology for instructional purposes



# Credit Acceleration Program (CAP)

Earn credit in high school graduation courses through passage of:

- End-of-Course Assessment
- Advanced Placement (AP) Exam
- College Level Examination Program (CLEP)



# Seal of Biliteracy

- Replaces BCPS' 2015-2016 recognition
- Creates two categories of competency
  - Gold
  - Silver
- New criteria:
  - Four credits in the same world language
    - (3.0 unweighted GPA)
  - Qualifying score on IB, AICE, AP, or SAT II
  - Alternative demonstrations of competency
- FLDOE created insignias and transcript indicators
