

# Per Florida State Statute 1003.03:

School Boards may approve scheduling flexibility for **new students** enrolled <u>after</u> Survey 2 Date Certain – **Friday, October 14, 2016**:

- +3 students in Grades Pk-3 classrooms
- +5 students in Grades 4-12 classrooms

In November 2015, the Broward County School Board approved to further limit the total number of additional students per teacher, so that in:

- Grades 6-8, teachers would not be assigned more than 15 new students, and in
- Grades 9-12, teachers would not be assigned more than 18 new students.

# **Next Steps: Key CSR Timeline Dates**

October 18<sup>th</sup> – RSBM – Post Survey 2 Scheduling Flexibility for Newly Enrolled Students

October 14<sup>th</sup> - November 11<sup>th</sup> - Schools correct errors in TERMS based on Reports from FDOE

November 11<sup>th</sup> – Survey 2 – Deadline for data corrections by schools to FDOE

December 1<sup>st</sup> TBD – FDOE Memorandum expected regarding Preliminary Penalty Calculation (Prior to Appeal)

December - TBD - CSR Appeals tentative due date to FDOE\*

January - TBD - TBD RSBM - 2017-18 CSR Compliance Plan\*

February 1<sup>st</sup> – CSR Compliance Plan (for schools not meeting CSR compliance) due to FDOE\*

Commissioner of Education recommends, subject to approval of the Legislative Budget Commission, the reduction of an alternate amount of funds from the district's class size categorical allocation.

\*Per Florida State Statute 1003.03 – If the District's 'Schools of Choice' and non-Charter schools are within compliance, appeals and CSR Compliance Plan(s) will not need to be filed with the FDOE.
