### 2017-18 School Boundary Process

- SAF's nominated members to serve on School Boundary Committee (SBC)
- Area Advisories selected representatives and alternates from the SAF nominees to serve on the SBC
- Staff met with community members who wished to propose change to school boundaries
- All proposed boundary changes posted to DSA website for community input
- Boundary meetings held for the South and North and Central areas in October and November
- School Boundary Public meeting for boundary change proposals to be presented to SBC
- SBC deliberation public meeting to vote on which proposals to recommend to School Board



# Considerations for Establishing School Boundaries

Consideration	Description
Class Size Impact (Required)	Will the requested change place any school involved in jeopardy of not meeting the Florida class size statute now or in the next five years?
Level of Service Impact (Required)	Are the schools involved projected to meet the tri-party agreement (Broward County, municipalities, School Board) school concurrency Level of Service?
Enrollment Impact	Will the requested change under enroll a school or cause it to exceed its gross capacity?
Diversity Impact	Will the proposed boundary change impact any demographic population significantly (+/- 5%)?
Feeder Pattern Impact	Does the requested change split or further divide the number of students feeding from one school to another?
School Proximity Impact	Will the requested change require students to travel further to get to school?
Neighborhood Integrity Impact	Will the requested change assign students living in a neighborhood to different schools?
Natural Barrier Impact	Will the requested change require students to cross natural barriers such as major roads or waterways?




### **Community Proposals**

# Community Proposal C11- Lauderdale Lakes Middle and Silver Lakes Middle


- Eliminates boundary through community

 Gives students living in City of Tamarac priority seats





## Community Proposal C7- Stoneman Douglas and Coral Glades High Schools



- Significant travel time for students west of University Dr. to Riverglades




