

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Below is an Executive Summary of the First Amendment to Agreement between The School Board of Broward County, Florida and Broward College – Purchase of Textbooks for Dual Enrollment with Broward College.

Requested Action	Approve the First Amendment to Agreement between The School Board of Broward County, Florida (SBBC) and Broward College (BC) regarding the purchase of textbooks for Dual Enrollment.

Project Description	The School Board of Broward County, Florida and Broward College have had an ongoing agreement to supply students with access to Dual Enrollment courses and the necessary instructional materials that go along with those courses. In the past SBBC purchased instructional materials from Broward College’s appointed textbook agent. Due to changes in the articulation agreement between SBBC and BC this option is no longer possible. This First Amendment to Agreement between SBBC and BC enables BC to sell the instructional materials directly to SBBC while allowing SBBC to maintain its specifications regarding the new procedures for how students acquire, use, and return books.
Impact Statement	This agreement is a viable mechanism that enables SBBC students to access their instructional materials directly from BC rather than going through a separate agreement with a third-party vendor
