Music Equipment Replacement is being managed separately by the District's Music and Performing Arts Department. Per the most recent Bond Oversight Committee (BOC) quarterly report (data through 3/31/2017), on January 18, 2017, the SBBC Board Item FF-1 accelerated SMART music program Years 4 & 5 to Year 3. 100% of the orders were processed; and all 134 items were delivered and received.
