Project Description	To provide adult and secondary educational services to youth adjudicated as adults under the age of 18 and adults inmates that are age 18 years and older, from commencement of board approval pursuant to Florida State Statute 1003.53 and 948.037. The educational services follows an alternative calendar of 241 days for adult education and 196 day calendar for secondary education. Ensure that all inmates under 22 years of age who qualify for special educational services and programs pursuant to the IDEA are offered secondary educational services pursuant to Florida State Statute 944.801. This educational program services juveniles and adults who are under the supervision of the Broward Sheriff's Office and services provided by Whiddon-Rogers Education Center.
Evaluation Plan	SBBC will annually assess student achievement using District and State approved assessments such as the Florida Standards Assessment (FSA), End of Course Exam (EOC), number of High School Diplomas awarded, number of High School Equivalency Diplomas awarded as established by the Florida Department of Education, and post-secondary career opportunities: Nine students passed the FSA; 10 students passed EOC's (American History, Civics, & Biology); and 7 High School Equivalency Diplomas awarded.
Research Methodology	Florida State Statutes 944.801, 948.037, 1003.27 and 1003.51 support the rationale of this program, which suggest adult correctional facilities and local school district collaborate to provide educational services to inmates in correctional facilities.
