- Band in the process of purchasing travel uniforms...165 uniforms / \$85.00 each
- Dillard is currently a "C" school, however expects to be a "B" school next year
- Homecoming activities Friday night Pep Rally open to the public and Saturday Homecoming parade and tailgating
- Dillard will be offering "Intro to College" as a dual enrollment course at the school with minimum GPA of 2.5, limited spots available, and the teacher will be required to have a Master's degree in any course.
- 1st production "Ain't Misbehaving" will show on the following dates Nov. 12 & 13 also Nov. 18-20.
- NAF Program Certification (also explained by Mrs. Butler-Overstreet) which is offers industry specific courses in Health Science, Hospitality & Tourism, or Finance during student's freshman through senior years. Upon successful completion of the program the student will receive NAF Certification.
- Last meeting approved to rename football field and track area "Robert Green Field", however the school staff has recommended "Robert Green & Johnny Alexander Field". Mr. Johnny Alexander wants to recommend that the field is name after Robert Green.



ROBERT GREEN TRACK


- The meeting was called to order and chaired by Johnny Robinson at 10:15a.m.
