GENERAL OVERVIEW:

RFQ 18-036C was advertised on DemandStar on May 18, 2017. This item is for Board approval of the Professional Services Agreement between The School Board of Broward County, Florida and Rodriguez Architects Inc., for professional design services for McArthur High School. Design Professional shall develop a complete set of design documents that can be permitted for construction, along with construction contract administration services. The design documents scope for this project includes, but not limited to, replacement of Building 6, safety/security upgrade, fire sprinklers, STEM lab improvements, improvements to or replacement of Building 1 (requires additional analysis to determine if the building is in a condition that would warrant replacement or if the building is sufficiently sound that would make improvements appropriate), media center improvements, HVAC improvements, electrical improvements, building envelope improvements, and other items that may be required to execute the Board Approved scope.

According to School Board Policy 7003, Selection of Engineers and Architects, and pursuant to the Consultant's Competitive Negotiation Act, the Qualification Selection Evaluation Committee ("QSEC") selected Rodriguez Architects, Inc., and the Negotiating Committee met with Rodriguez Architects, Inc., and negotiated a fixed fee.

The Architectural/Professional Liability Insurance has been agreed upon pursuant to Part 9.2 – Article 9 of the Professional Services Agreement based upon the Project Contract Cost.

This Agreement has been reviewed and approved as to form and legal content by the Office of the General Counsel.
