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Process for Setting Current District Strategic Plan Targets




Principals' Meeting May 19, 2016

- Twenty-eight (28) principals reviewed historical data trends
- Facilitated conversations in groups of nine (9), set by school level
- Each principal provided his or her suggested target via survey instrument
- Individual's input were aggregated and reviewed by participants
- Group reached consensus
- Statistical models, computed independently of principals' group, were shared with group
- Consensus reached for desired targets


Progress Toward Meeting Current Targets

Principals' Focus Group September 29, 2017

Who?	Seven Principals: 2 Elementary, 2 Middle, 2 High, and 1 Center
What?	 Considered Three Options: Option 1: Maintain Current Strategic Plan 2019 Stretch Targets Option 2: Adopt Proposed Recalibrated Strategic Plan Targets for ALL Strategic Plan Objectives Option 3: Adopt Proposed Recalibrated Strategic Plan Targets for SELECT Strategic Plan Objectives
	 Consensus: Apply 90 percent CI stretch targets to all High-Quality Instructional (HQI) goals
Why?	 Methods and standards should be consistent for all HQI goals Principals regularly review outcomes and naturally increase their targets when they approach or reach their goals Remaining with lower targets once reached, such as with algebra, may lead to false sense of accomplishment 90 percent CI is high but attainable BUT Need to ensure necessary support and resources for at-risk schools and students



Strategic Plan Baseline and Original Strategic Plan Stretch Targets by HQI Objective




