

Supporting Summary Explanation and Background for SIP Continuation:

The State requires each District to develop a District Improvement & Assistance Plan that describes how the district will provide assistance and intervention to schools that risk not meeting the state standards or not making annual measurable objectives by implementing the required support and interventions under Differentiated Accountability. The District Improvement & Assistance Plan was developed collaboratively with District divisions and departments. It is designed to deliver a single voice of support services to the districts most critical schools and students performing below proficiency levels and reflects the requirements under Differentiated Accountability.

The School Improvement Plan is an on line template aligned with AdvancEd Accreditation Standards and the tenets of the Best Blueprint: A Focused and Authentic PLC, An Embedded High Quality RtI Process, Optimal Internal/External Relationships, and Scaling Up Best Practices. The BCPS School Improvement Plan template is the primary artifact that every school and its stakeholders will use to review data, set goals, create an action plan and monitor progress.
