Project Overview:

This project consists of remodeling restroom 308A with a new ADA compliant clinic restroom, replacement of shower seat and grab bar in restroom 308B and installation of an automatic door opener in restroom 201A.

The project is currently in the construction phase. Drywall, plumbing rough, electrical rough are completed and door frame has been installed.

Key Issues:

Item #1 – Installation of pipe lining and new sanitary line: During the construction phase it was discovered that the existing sanitary line showed signs of corrosion. After investigative work was done it was determined that a pipe lining was the best course of action. A new sanitary line was also added due to incorrect existing as-built drawings. (Unforeseen Condition: \$7,989; Add 0 Days)

Action Plan:

The design drawings have been modified so that they reflect the changes described above. This change order has been reviewed for entitlement and cost by Heery and Atkins with a recommendation for approval.
