First Amendment to the Cooperative Agreement with The Broward Sheriff's Office

**REQUESTED ACTION:**

Approve the amendment between The School Board of Broward County, Florida, and The Broward Sheriff's Office. The amendment period will begin after School Board approval and shall conclude on June 30, 2019.

**SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:**

Under this First Amendment to an agreement between the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) and The School Board of Broward County (SBBC), Florida, the BSO will reimburse SBBC for the General Education Development (GED) test cost for each inmate that participates in the GED test. Over the amendment period, the total amount shall not exceed \$36,000, which will entitle 1,200 individual inmate registrations on a rolling basis over multiple successive quarterly terms. One registration covers the full enrollment tuition for one term for one inmate. This First Amendment has been reviewed and approved as to form and legal content by the Office of the General Counsel.

Project Description	Under this second amendment to an agreement between the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) and The School Board of Broward County (SBBC), Florida, the BSO will reimburse SBBC for the General Education Development (GED) test cost for each inmate that participates in the GED test. Over the amendment period, the total amount shall not exceed \$36,000, which will entitle 1,200 individual inmate registrations on a rolling basis over multiple successive quarterly terms. One registration covers the full enrollment tuition for one term for one inmate.
Evaluation Plan	This agreement aims to increase the number of inmates that obtain a GED.
Research Methodology	Research also suggests that confinement does not meet the needs of juveniles nor improve the community, as it interrupts education and negatively affects employability. A 2013 study from the RAND Corporation found that high school dropouts are 63 times more likely to be in an institution than college graduates and inmates who participate in a correction education program have 43 percent lower odds of returning to prison than those who did not.
Alignment with Strategic Plan	This grant supports District Strategic Plan Goal 1: High-Quality Instruction through the payment of GED testing for inmates and District Strategic Plan Goal 2: Continuous Improvement.
Level of Support provided by GAGP	GAGP staff were responsible for routing the amendment through the legal department, developing the executive summary for the Board approval, and preparing a hard copy of the file for record keeping.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO  
AGREEMENT**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of this 19<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2017, by and between:

**THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA**

“hereinafter referred to as the “SBBC,” a body corporate and political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose principal place of business is 600 Southeast Third Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301

and

**SCOTT J ISRAEL, as SHERIFF OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA** hereinafter referred to as the “SHERIFF,” whose principal place of business is 2601 West Broward Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33312.

**WHEREAS**, the SBBC and SHERIFF entered into an Agreement dated September 6, 2017 (hereafter “Agreement”); and

**WHEREAS**, SBBC and SHERIFF mutually desire to amend certain provisions of the Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants embodied herein, and other valuable considerations, the parties to this contract mutually agree as follows:

**1.01 Recitals.** The Parties agree that the foregoing recitals are true and correct and that such recitals are incorporated herein by reference.

**1.02 Amended Provisions.** The Parties hereby agree to replace Article 2.21 of the Agreement, by interlineation, to read as follows:

**2.21 GED ADMINISTRATION.**

**2.21a GED Testing.** The SHERIFF agrees to reimburse the SBBC for the General Education Development (GED) test cost for each inmate that participates in the GED test.

**2.21b GED Tuition.** The SHERIFF shall pay a lump sum total consideration to SBBC, not to exceed Thirty Six Thousand Dollars (\$36,000.00) which will entitle SHERIFF to One Thousand Two Hundred (1,200) individual inmate registrations on a rolling basis over multiple successive quarterly terms. One registration covers the full enrollment tuition for one term for one inmate. Any additional consideration for additional registrations, shall be agreed to be the parties and invoiced to SHERIFF by SBBC throughout the term of this Agreement but subject to Grant funding. SHERIFF shall provide adequate classroom space at the Jail Facilities for training.

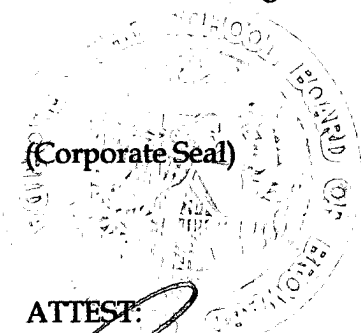
**1.03 Order of Precedence Among Agreement Documents.** In the event of conflict between the provisions of the Agreement and the provisions contained herein, the provisions of the following documents shall take precedence in this order:

- a) The First Amendment to Agreement; and
- b) The Agreement


**1.04 Other Provisions Remain in Force.** Except as expressly provided herein, all other portions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.

**1.05 Authority.** Each person signing this First Amendment to Agreement on behalf of either party individually warrants that he or she has full legal power to execute this First Amendment to Agreement on behalf of the party for whom he or she is signing, and to bind and obligate such party with respect to all provisions contained in this First Amendment to Agreement.





Cooperative Agreement between The Broward Sheriff's Office and Whiddon-Rogers Education Center

**REQUESTED ACTION:**  
Approve Cooperative Agreement between The Broward Sheriff's Office and Whiddon-Rogers Education Center.

**SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:**  
To provide adult and secondary educational services to youth adjudicated as adults under the age of 18 and adult inmates that are age 18 years and older, from commencement of board approval pursuant to Florida State Statute 1003.53 and 948.037. The educational services follows an alternative calendar of 241 days for adult education and 196 day calendar for secondary education. Ensure that all inmates under 22 years of age who qualify for special educational services and programs pursuant to the IDEA are offered secondary educational services pursuant to Florida State Statute 944.801. This educational program services juveniles and adults who are under the supervision of the Broward Sheriff's Office and services provided by Whiddon-Rogers Education Center. This Agreement has been reviewed and approved as to form and legal content by the Office of the General Counsel.
