1,035,033

- The capital budget as adopted in September includes an estimated \$5 million in sale of land, however through December 2017, the District has collected a total of \$6,035,033 which exceeds what was budgeted by \$1,035,033.
- In October, 2017 the District collected \$3,124,700 for the sale of the Rock Island site.
- In December, 2017 the District collected \$2,910,333 for the sale of the New River Circle site.
