Project Description	The FLDOE Instructional Materials adoption schedule was revised in 2015 aligning subjects to include all of K-12 for specific subject areas. This revision affects the upcoming adoption for K-5 Mathematics. The result is that current adoptions will end one (1) year before the new adoption begins, creating a "Gap" during which time there will not be sufficient instructional materials in elementary classrooms. Consumable instructional materials and digital licenses will need to be purchased in order to bridge this Gap.
Impact Statement	 To evaluate the acquisition and implementation of these instructional materials, the Office of Academics will: Ensure that all schools have adequate instructional materials via the Instructional Materials Management System and correlation of book orders with course enrollments via the Student Information System. Ensure effective implementation of these materials through professional development and track participation in opportunities offered through the District's Professional Development Management System.
