Elementary Mathematics Gap Purchase 2018-2019

The FLDOE Instructional Materials adoption schedule was revised in 2015 aligning subjects to include all of K-12 for specific subject areas. This revision affects the upcoming adoption for K-5 Mathematics. The result is that current adoptions will end one (1) year before the new adoption begins, creating a “Gap” during which time there will not be sufficient instructional materials in elementary classrooms. Consumable instructional materials and digital licenses will need to be purchased in order to bridge this Gap.

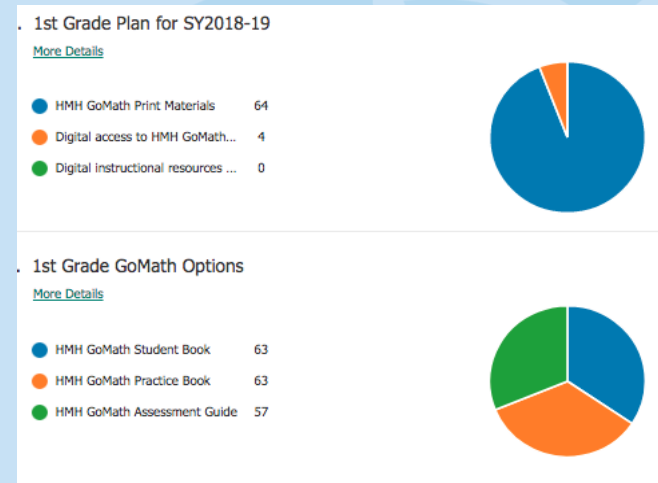
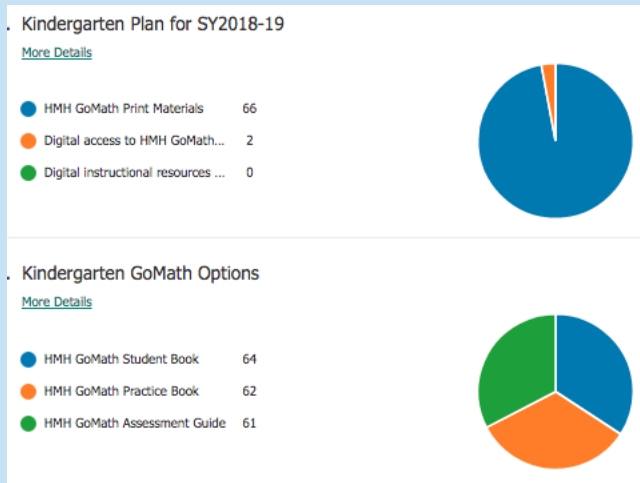
Needs Assessment Survey

- 150 Elementary Math Contacts were surveyed (68 responses) to identify individual school needs for K-5 teachers and students.
- Choices included:
 - Print Go Math! Materials (with Digital access)
 - Digital-Only Access to Go Math!
 - Digital Access to Open Educational Resources Available via Canvas
- Responses that included print materials were asked which they considered necessary:
 - Go Math! Student Edition
 - Go Math! Practice Book
 - Go Math! Assessment Guide
- Responses indicate that teachers feel that all three of the physical books were necessary to continue to effectively instruct K-5 students across the District.



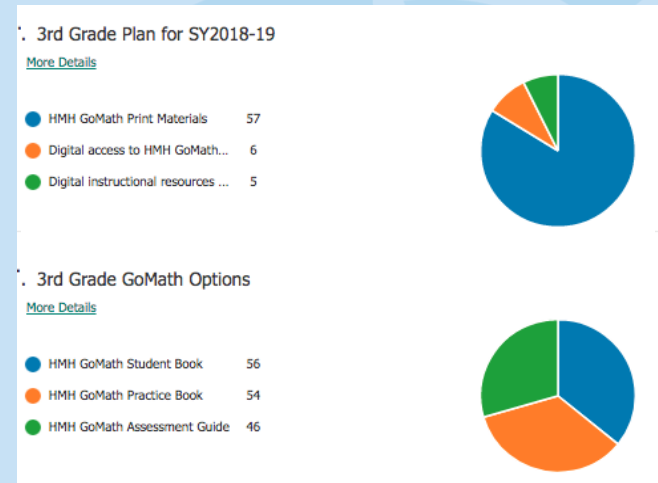
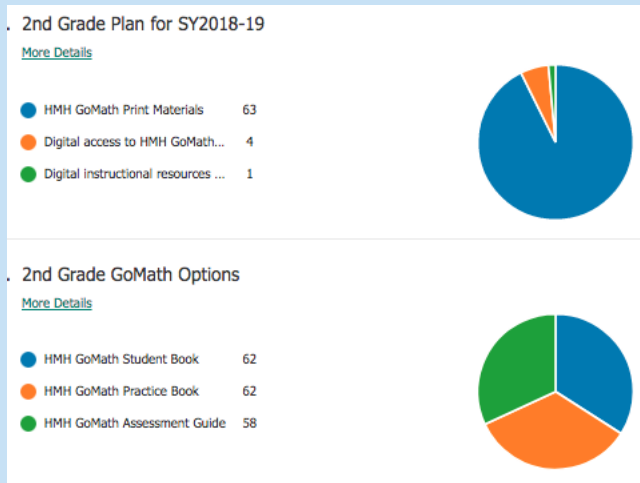

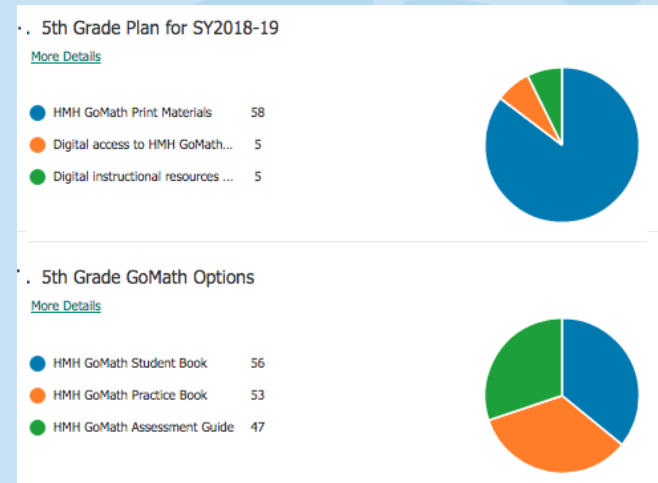
