**GENERAL OVERVIEW:**

Authorization to award a Lump Sum Contract for construction at Deerfield Beach High School, Single Point of Entry improvements, to FHP Tectonics Corp., in the amount of \$415,000.

The Letter of Approval to advertise Construction Bids for projects up to \$750,000 or less has been received. The Letter of Recommendation to Issue a Permit has been issued by the Building Department. Bids were received on January 17, 2018 from a total of four (4) bidders. Procurement and Warehouse Services has recommended the award of the project to FHP Tectonics Corp. as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder that met the specifications, terms and conditions of the bid.

The original overall project budget for the Single Point of Entry improvements at Deerfield Beach High School is \$540,000. The proposal from FHP Tectonics Corp. in the amount of \$415,000 is within the available funds and requires no additional funding to proceed with the Single Point of Entry improvements. The existing project funds are also sufficient to establish a 10% construction contingency in the amount of \$41,500.

FHP Tectonics Corp. is not a Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) certified company. However, the Contractor has committed to exceed the District's M/WBE Participation Goal of 25% for this project through the use of Certified M/WBE Subcontractors.

This Agreement has been reviewed and approved as to form and legal content by the Office of the General Counsel.
