TITLE:

Broward Sheriff's Office Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF) First Amendment

REQUESTED ACTION:

Approve the First Amendment to the Agreement between The School Board of Broward County, Florida (as operator of Whiddon-Rogers Education Center), and the Broward Sheriff's Office. The First Amendment begins the day of School Board approval and ends on September 1, 2018.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:

The intention of this First Amendment is to extend the term of the Agreement. This extension will provide additional time to utilize the grant funding. The First Amendment to the Agreement has been approved as to form and legal content by the Office of the General Counsel. This Amendment will be executed after School Board approval.

Goal 1: High Quality Instruction Goal 2: Continuous Improvement Goal 3: Effective Communication

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The LETF grant supports the Criminal Justice Academy at Whiddon-Rogers Education Center. The original grant awarded \$7,763 for the LETF program. This First Amendment extends the term of the original Agreement providing additional time to utilize \$5,185 in carryover funds. There is no additional financial impact to the District.

Project Description	Under the auspices of Florida Statute, Chapter 932.701-706, "Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act," the Broward Sheriff's Office make funds available for distribution in the Broward community. These funds are better known by their common name - Law Enforcement Trust Funds (LETF). Through the use of LETF, Broward County Public Schools is the recipient of a grant award to support the Criminal Justice Academy at Whiddon-Rogers Education Center. The Criminal Justice Academy is designed to introduce students to various careers in all major areas in the criminal justice system. Students are provided with information to develop tools necessary to work and become successful in the criminal justice community.
Evaluation Plan	Students will be evaluated on their knowledge gains in these areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify the history, goals, and career opportunities; • Interpret ethics and professionalism; • Describe court systems and trial processes; • Discuss the juvenile justice system; • Describe the correctional system; • Utilize personal, interpersonal, and communication skills.
Research Methodology	The data suggests that there is a need to implement the Criminal Justice Academy at Whiddon-Rogers Education Center with our population of students due to our student population who, for a variety of reasons were not successful in the traditional school setting and are in need of a second opportunity to obtain their high school diploma.
Alignment with Strategic Plan	This grant supports District Strategic Goal 1: High-Quality Instruction by incorporating college and career readiness skills from the criminal justice and security sector.
Level of Support provided by GAGP	GAGP staff facilitated the amendment review with the high school and the General Counsel's Office, wrote the executive summary for the board agenda, prepared a hard copy of the file for record keeping, and managed the item for the Board's approval.

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the Agreement by and between SCOTT J. ISRAEL, as Sheriff of Broward County, Florida (hereinafter referred to as "SHERIFF") and THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, (hereinafter referred to as "GRANTEE") is made and entered this 10th day of April, 2018.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on or about September 1, 2016, GRANTEE and SHERIFF entered into an Agreement for Disbursement of Law Enforcement Trust Fund monies; and,

WHEREAS, the agreement expired as of August 31, 2017;

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of modifying the term of the Agreement to extend the term of the agreement making it expire on September 1, 2018.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The foregoing recitations are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. The Agreement is hereby made extended until September 1, 2018, nunc pro tunc to August 31, 2017.
3. Except as modified herein, all remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement and the First Amendment to the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
