Project Description	Under the auspices of Florida Statute, Chapter 932.701-706, "Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act," the Broward Sheriff's Office make funds available for distribution in the Broward community. These funds are better known by their common name - Law Enforcement Trust Funds (LETf). Through the use of LETf, Broward County Public Schools is the recipient of a grant award to support the Criminal Justice Academy at Whiddon-Rogers Education Center. The Criminal Justice Academy is designed to introduce students to various careers in all major areas in the criminal justice system. Students are provided with information to develop tools necessary to work and become successful in the criminal justice community.

Research Methodology	The data suggests that there is a need to implement the Criminal Justice Academy at Whiddon-Rogers Education Center with our population of students due to our student population who, for a variety of reasons were not successful in the traditional school setting and are in need of a second opportunity to obtain their high school diploma.
