## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

## Recommendation of \$500,000 or Greater 18-160B – Letter and Legal-Sized Paper

This request is to approve the recommendation to award Invitation to Bid (ITB) 18-160B – Letter and Legal-sized Paper for a two (2) year contract from Aug 1, 2018 through July 31, 2020, with a spending authority of \$2,450.000.

The School Board of Broward County, Florida, released Invitation to Bid (ITB) 18-160B on January 30, 2018, and was opened on February 26, 2018. Procurement & Warehousing Services received seven (7) bids, of which three (3) are certified Small/Minority/Women Business Enterprise, vendors.

This ITB 18-160B was issued to replace ITB 16-007B which expires on July 30, 2018.

Letter and legal-sized paper is needed throughout the District for daily use to print special projects, documents, emails, facsimiles, etc. This ITB will allow schools and departments to order these items directly from our Warehouse.

## **Financial Impact**

The estimated spend for a two (2) year contract is \$2,750,000, which was determined based on historical usage reports of the previous contract and forecasted expenditures. The amount requested will provide adequate funding for the District to continue ordering copy paper as needed.
