TITLE:
Agreement with the University of Florida Board of Trustees

REQUESTED ACTION:
Approve the Agreement between The School Board of Broward County, Florida (as operator of Elementary Schools: Broadview, Castle Hill and Larkdale) and The Board of Trustees of the University of Florida (UF). The Agreement term begins upon full execution by all parties and ends on June 30, 2020.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:
The James Patterson Literacy Challenge at UF will address persistent problems in early literacy by working with schools to change their literacy culture. UF will accomplish this through transformative professional learning experiences for teachers and school leaders. This invitational grant did not require an application. The Agreement has been reviewed and approved as to form and legal content by the Office of the General Counsel. The Agreement will be executed after School Board approval.
