## Continuation of Summary

These programs align with the District's Social/Emotional Learning (SEL), Re-Imagining Middle Grades, and Mental Health Plan initiatives by providing research-supported curriculum, materials, and assistance to meet the multi-tiered needs of all students.

Participating schools will be required to embed the selected Sandy Hook Promise Foundation, Inc. (SHP) programs into existing or new "pro-social" clubs to maintain implementation of the initiative after initial launch. SHP will provide all necessary resources, materials, training, and if necessary, staff (except pro-social club leaders) to implement the programs with fidelity in District and charter schools.

Prior to this contract's approval, approximately one hundred and forty (140) District schools have already expressed interest in these programs and schools without similar, existing programs at their schools will be encouraged to participate with the same supports and resources.
