**Re: Cessation of Educational Services at Carlton Palms Education Center, Inc. effective July 1, 2018 for Mikaela Borenstein**

Dear Mr. Runcie and Dr. Hickman:

Carlton Palms Educational Center, Inc. was placed on a Court Ordered Receivership under my direction effective May 17, 2018. The Agency for Persons with Disabilities has obtained a Judge's Order for all individuals currently residing at Carlton Palms Educational Center, Inc. to be transitioned to community residential group homes and to phase out the current Comprehensive Transitional Educational Program license which is the license that allows Carlton Palms to provide educational services.

Due to the receivership process, Carlton Palms will be transitioning out all individuals either into other vendor operated Community Residences or transitioning those individuals who cannot find placement in Florida back to their home state. While that transition process is happening, Carlton Palms will continue to provide safe and secure services to the individuals in its program. To that effect, Carlton Palms will cease providing educational services to the school-aged individuals that reside in our program. The current educational contract is due to expire on Saturday, June 30, 2018 and educational services to these individuals will cease effective July 1, 2018. Pursuant to the Court's June 27, 2018 Order Instructing Receiver to Terminate Contracts, please be advised the educational services contract with you is hereby terminated.

Carlton Palms Educational Center, Inc. will continue to provide residential services to these individuals under the current Medicaid Waiver Services agreement with the Agency for Persons with Disabilities until they have been transitioned to other providers in the community.

We will assist in working with you and the Lake County School District for coordinating educational services for Fiscal Year 2018/2019, while the individuals remain in Carlton Palms for residential services.
