Any person who is adversely affected by the decision or intended decision shall file a notice of protest, in writing, within 72 hours after the posting of the notice of decision or intended decision. The formal written protest shall be filed within ten (10) days after the date the notice of protest is filed. Failure to file a notice of protest or failure to file a formal written protest shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under this chapter. Section 120.57(3)(b), Florida Statutes, states that "The formal written protest shall state with particularity the facts and law upon which the protest is based." Saturdays, Sundays, state holidays and days during which the District is closed shall be excluded in the computation of the 72-hour time period provided. Filings shall be at the office of the Director of Procurement & Warehousing Services, 7720 West Oakland Park Boulevard, Suite 323, Sunrise, Florida 33351. Any person who files an action protesting an intended decision shall post with the School Board, at the time of filing the formal written protest, a bond, payable to The School Board of Broward County, Florida, (SBBC), in an amount equal to one percent (1%) of the estimated value of the contract. Failure to post the bond required by SBBC Policy 3320, Part VIII, Purchasing Policies, Section N, within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of the right to protest.

It is recommended that for reasons stated below, the bids as stated be rejected for not complying with bid requirements.

- 1) Reject bid from **GL Staffing Services, Inc.** Section 7, Bid Summary Sheet, states: ***“Vendor must fill out the attached Summary Sheet electronically with the corresponding prices per unit of measure as stated. No handwritten summary sheets will be accepted”***. Bidder is not responsive as they failed to submit an electronic Summary Sheet, the prices are handwritten.
  
- 2) Reject bid from **Spur Employment Inc.** Section 12, Bidder’s References, states: ***“Bidders must provide with the bid, a list of references from three established firms for whom bidder is presently providing temporary personnel. Firms must be located within the tri-county area (Miami-Dade, Broward and Palm Beach)”***. Bidder is not responsive as they failed to submit references from Firms located in the tri-county area. All references submitted are from out-of-state.
