The original scope awarded to Tropic Fence, Inc. included a concrete sidewalk and electrical items which require a General Contractors license. Since Tropic Fence, Inc. does not have a General Contractors license, these items are required to be removed from the work being executed by Tropic Fence, Inc. (Owner Directed – (\$17,585);

Concrete sidewalk and electrical items were completed by Grace & Naeem Udin, Inc. under a separate Continuing Contract - Construction Services Minor Project.
