Project Description	<p>Yearly update to the 2017/2018 BCPS PL System as required by Administrative Rule 6A-5.071 Master Inservice Plan.</p> <p>Rule 6A-5.071 Master Inservice Plan, Section (4) Submission, Amendment and Requirement:</p> <p>(a) By September 1 of each year, the school district shall update the master inservice plan, based on the results of the review conducted pursuant to paragraph (4)(d) of this rule, and the district school board, director of a developmental research school, or governing authority of an eligible state educational agency or organization of private schools shall approve the plan pursuant to the criteria and procedures in subsections (3) and (4) of this rule.</p> <p>(b) By October 1 of each year, the school district shall submit a letter to the Commissioner verifying the district school board, director of a developmental research school, or governing authority of an eligible state educational agency or organization of private schools has approved the master inservice plan and the plan meets the criteria in subsection (3) of this rule.</p>
Florida Department of Education Directive to Florida School Districts	<p>Rule 6A-5.071 Master Inservice Plan requires Florida School Districts to update Master Inservice Plans and submit a letter to the Commissioner verifying the district school board has approved the master inservice plan by October 1 of every year. District Master Inservice Plans must meet the criteria set forth in subsection (3) of this rule. Specifically, Districts were directed to include the following information in the Master Inservice Plans to ensure compliance with HB 7069 updates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Training for teacher mentors as part of the professional development certification and education competency program (PDCP) to include components of teacher development, peer coaching, time management and other topics determined by the department;</i>

- *Inservice activities and support targeted to the individual needs of new teachers participating in the school district's professional development certification and education competency program (PDCP);*
- *Specified training for reading coaches, classroom teachers and school administrations in methods of identifying conditions such as dyslexia, instructional techniques that are proven to improve reading performance and using data to make instructional decisions based on individual student needs; and*
- *Training to all elementary grades instructional personnel to meet s. 1012.585(3)(f), F.S.*
- *Require the department to disseminate to school districts model professional development that includes effective mentorship activities for new teachers and training for teacher mentors.*
