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| TITLE: Incumbent Worker Training (IWT) Contract between The School Board of Broward County, Florida (SBBC) and CareerSource Broward and accompanying Agreement with SBBC and The District Board of Trustees of Broward College, Florida (BC) |
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| REQUESTED ACTION: Approve a cost reimbursement Contract between SBBC and CareerSource Broward and the accompanying Agreement between SBBC and BC. The Contract period shall commence after School Board approval and shall expire June 30, 2019. The Agreement period shall commence after School Board approval and shall expire on June 30, 2019. |
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| SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND: The Office of Academics, in partnership with BC and CareerSource Broward, was awarded an Incumbent Worker Training Program Grant to assist employees (teachers) who must complete required training or coursework to retain their employment. The Broward Educator Certification (BEC) program at BC offers teachers hired on a temporary teaching certificate a program of study and practice to help satisfy the education semester hours the State of Florida requires for full certification. Teachers completing the coursework are then eligible to apply for a Professional Educator's Certificate necessary to retain employment. The program will support up to 65 full time teachers currently employed in the District or Charter school. This Contract and Agreement have been reviewed and approved as to form and legal content by the Office of the General Counsel. |
