

Continuation of Summary Explanation and Background

A component of the School District's process entails that during safety inspections or when notification is received that certain portables pose health or safety issues, and therefore are unsafe for occupation, due diligent measures will be immediately implemented, including seeking specific funding allocation from the School Board to enable immediate demolition of the subject portables.

The Sixty-five (65) portables depicted in Attachment 1 have been declared unsatisfactory due to their deteriorated physical condition. However, before the portables can be demolished, they must first be declared surplus to comply with the provisions of Sections 1013.28 (2) and 274.05, Florida Statutes. Declaring these portables as surplus does not have a financial impact. Funding was not allocated in the 2018/19 - 2022/23 District Educational Facilities Plan (DEFP) for the demolition of portables due to significant financial constraints the District is currently under. Thus, funds to enable the demolition of any of the sixty-five (65) portables would be requested when critical safety issues are identified and approval of the School Board for specific funds are completed.
