## Credit Recovery

a. Credit Recovery courses are credit-bearing courses with specific content requirements.
b. Students enrolled in a Credit Recovery course must have previously attempted the corresponding course and/or End-of-Course (EOC) assessment.
c. Credit Recovery courses are not bound by section 1003.436 (1) (a), Florida Statutes (F.S.), requiring a minimum of 135 hours of bona fide instruction (120 hours in a school/district implementing block scheduling) in a designed course of study that contains student performance standards.
d. Credit Recovery courses shall only be used for credit recovery, grade forgiveness, or remediation for students needing to prepare for an EOC assessment retake.
e. Upon successful completion of a Credit Recovery course, students will also be awarded the equivalent credit in the corresponding core subject area course.

## Middle School Promotion

2. Promotion from 6 th to 7 th and 7 th to 8 th Grades
a. A student must pass a minimum of four, year-long courses or the equivalent, two of which must be in English, Mathematics, Science, or Social Studies.
3. Promotion from $8^{\text {th }}$ to $9^{\text {th }}$ Grade
b. In order for a student to be promoted to high school from a school that includes middle grades, 6, 7, and 8, the student must successfully complete three courses in English, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies including Civics.

## School-based ACCEL Criteria

## When the accelerated promotion occurs

within the school, the principal may establish school-based eligibility criteria with district approval (1002.3105(4)(b)1.).

Intervention
Performance through
RtI Process
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Student receives intensive Tier 2 or Tier 3 intervention through the RtI/MTSS, IEP, EP, ELL, Section 504, or other district-approved process and demonstrates increased performance based on progress monitoring data (increase in student achievement to the level set by the goal of the intervention). Student will continue to receive intensive intervention in the subsequent grade level.

b. A final grade for a full year middle school course will be determined based upon the total number of points earned in all marking periods-quarters according to the following chart.
