**WHEREAS**, the School Board of Broward County, Florida did pursuant to Chapters 200 and 1011, Florida Statutes, approve the tentative millage rates for the fiscal year July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, at the public hearing and in full compliance with Chapter 200, Florida Statutes, the School Board of Broward County, Florida adopted the tentative millage rate for the fiscal year 2018-19 in the amounts of
