Continuation of Summary Explanation and Background

In compliance with state law, the current TRILA is between The School Board of Broward County, Florida; Broward County, and 27 Broward County Municipalities. The TRILA is overseen by a 15 member Oversight Committee, five each appointed by the School Board, the Broward County Commission, and the 27 Municipalities.

Section 1, Article II-Membership, of the Oversight Committee By-Laws, states that "Each appointing body shall appoint/reappoint their members for two-year terms. Each member's two-year term shall begin on the date of their official appointment by their appointing body".

Mr. Curtin is recommended for one of the five School Board appointments on the Committee. Mr. Lew Naylor, who served on the Committee since December 12, 2006, is finishing his term on December 20, 2018. In compliance with the School District's protocol to enable the School Board's appointment to the Oversight Committee, the Facility Planning and Real Estate Department reached out to the community to seek interest from other civically engaged individuals to serve on the Oversight Committee. The result is Mr. Curtin as the viable candidate to replace Mr. Naylor. Therefore, staff recommends that Mr. Timothy G. Curtin be appointed to the Oversight Committee.
