

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

### **Recreation License Agreement between The School Board of Broward County, Florida and the City of Hollywood**

Recreation License Agreements (RLA) (formerly referred to as Master Lease Agreements (MLA)) are long-term agreements that are structured to allow for the long-term continuous use of recreational facilities (ie, playgrounds, ballfields, handball and basketball courts, tennis courts, tracks, etc.) identified in the RLA. The term/length of RLAs vary, but typically range from twenty (20) to fifty (50) years.

The City desires to enter into a new RLA for twenty-five (25) years, which will allow the City to utilize the recreational facilities located to the east and west of Hollywood Hills Elementary School during non-school hours. In addition to the RLA, the City of Hollywood for years, has had partnership agreements with SBBC, and currently has a Reciprocal Use Agreement (RUA) with SBBC.
